Dear Ms. Burns:


On May 8, 2008, we wrote to you in regard to a homeless person ("Cathleen") who is keeping cats and other animals within traps/cages/carriers, mounted on and attached to grocery carts. In our letter, we presented facts and articulated our position, i.e., that the conditions in which these animals are being kept is in violation of Section 711-1109, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

We requested your assistance in removing the animals from Cathleen's possession, because we have documented conditions which we believe show that Cathleen is in clear violation of the law. We asked that you take action quickly to relieve the animals' suffering. Further, we stated that we do not want any animals to be euthanized as a result of the requested confiscation, and offered to work with you, and noted that we are willing to take the adult animals or any of the animals (if they cannot be adopted through the HHS) and make sure that they receive good homes. We provided you with information where Cathleen can be found.

It has been two weeks since we sent our letter to you, but, to date, we have received no response. As the animal control contractor for the City and County of Honolulu, it is your responsibility to respond to requests such as ours, where animals are being held continuously in violation of Hawaii's anti-cruelty statutes. Thus, we believe we have a right to a prompt response in this matter, and it is your obligation to provide that response on behalf of the animals, and to enforce the anti-cruelty statutes. We hope you will agree that, when animals are being held in cruel confinement, time is of the essence.

We are, therefore, making this second request for assistance in this matter. We remain hopeful that we can work together for the benefit of the animals, and that you will respond to our request in a timely manner.
