**SUBJECT: Request for Information and Documents  
Uniform Information Practices Act**

This request for documents is submitted pursuant to the provisions of the Uniform Information Practices Act ("UIPA"), Chapter 92F Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

We request that you provide forthwith, copies of any and all complaints and the disposition of such complaints, pertaining to the homeless woman ("Cathleen") and the animals in her possession, and any and all notes, investigative reports, photographs, e-mails, telephone messages, and all other documents regarding the woman and the animals she keeps.

We are in possession of both written and oral statements made by employees of the Hawaiian Humane Society ("HHS"), including two (2) humane officers, stating that the HHS has been conducting regular, weekly inspections of the conditions in which the homeless woman's animals have been kept, for many months. For approximately the past year to year and a half, the woman has been residing within the public right-of-way fronting the Department of Health building at 919 Ala Moana Blvd., Honolulu. We ask that all information and reports be made available to us.

We would like to point out that under the UIPA law, you have ten (10) business days in which to provide the requested information. Should you have any questions regarding this UIPA request, please do not hesitate to call us at (808) 779-8713.
